

### **The Forerunner School of Ministry**

There is a set criteria for The Forerunner School of Ministry to follow. Which includes a series of teachings, preaching and divine inspiration.

The Forerunner School of Ministry is a yearly program that is broken down into five tracks. Every track is covered with teachings, sermons and other criteria. Each track is designed to cover a major area of ministry. Here is the following breakdown of each track:

#### **Worship:**

This track is designed to learn different aspects of worship in the church and in your own personal life. You will also be a part of the FSM worship team, whether that may be playing an instrument, music lessons, or learning how to become a worshiper.

#### **Audio/Video:**

The technological world has increased over the years and this track is designed to keep students trained in the areas of graphic arts, power point, video and audio production, and CD/DVD duplication.

#### **Missions:**

This outreach track is formulated for reaching the lost in other areas of the world. You will have the opportunity to travel to places such as Singapore, Australia, Africa, and parts of Europe. You will set up crusades, conventions and prepare drama in these different areas.

#### **Pastoral:**

In this specific track, you will learn the principles of the Bible according to theologians of the Old and New Testament. You will also learn how to write a sermon, how to conduct altar calls and how to pastor people. You will know how to run an effective church, ministry, and family after this track.

#### **Evangelism:**

You will see evangelism from “the stage” point of view. You will learn what an evangelist has to go through in their day, how they conduct themselves and how they keep their integrity. You will participate in missions within the state, nationally, and internationally, and you will also learn how to witness and outreach to neighboring residents.

In addition to the ministry tracks, The Forerunner School of Ministry is a yearly program designed to disciple a student in the areas of leadership. Each year there is a set criteria that is placed upon the students in order to graduate from the program.

After your second year as a forerunner, you will have attained either an Associate’s Degree, and/or become a certified minister of the Assemblies of God. After your fourth year in the program, you should have earned a Bachelor’s Degree, Ministerial Degree, and/or have your License to preach in the Assemblies of God.
